

Privacy Policy

1. Who we are

- 1.1 We are IP MIRNYI ANDREI VIKTOROVICH located at SEVERNYI B-R, D. 6, KV./OF. 133, MOSCOW, RUSSIA. We are represented, for the purposes of this policy.
- 1.2 "This Privacy Policy sets out how we collect and use your personal information when you use our website www.why-ryzen.com ("Site") and the choices available to you in connection with our use of your personal information (the Privacy Policy)."

2. This Privacy Policy

- 2.1 "By making available the Services we, acting reasonably and in good faith, believe that you are aware of and accept this Privacy Policy."

3. Information Collected

3.1 Google Analytics and Yandex.Metrica

- 3.1.1 This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service of Google Inc. ("Google"), and Yandex.Metrica, a web analytics service of Yandex llc. ("Yandex"). Google Analytics and Yandex.Metrica uses "cookies". Cookies are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies, and how to disable cookies, visit <http://www.allaboutcookies.org>. The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website will usually be transmitted to and stored by Google on a server in the United States and to and stored by Yandex on a server in the Russian Federation. Only in exceptional cases is the full IP address transmitted to Google servers in the United States and then shortened. On behalf of the operator of this website, Google and Yandex will use this information to evaluate your utilization of the website, to prepare reports about the activities on the website and to provide additional services to the operator of the website related to the utilization of the website and the use of the Internet.
- 3.1.2 You may refuse the storage of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser; however, please note that if you do so you may not be able to use the full functionality of the website. - 3.2 When you visit the Site, we automatically collect certain information regarding technical devices, technical interaction with the Site (your host IP-address, your operating system, type of a browser, geographic position, time zone, the Internet provider) and your browsing behavior and further actions on the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as "Device Information".
- 3.3 We collect the Device Information **only by** using the Google Analytics and Yandex.Metrica.
- 3.4 We use the Device Information that we collect to help us screen for potential risk and fraud (in particular, your IP address), and more generally to improve and optimize

our Site (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Site).

4. How do I reject cookies?

5. "We use the information we collect from you for the purposes of:

5.1 We process your data for the purposes identified above, as necessary, (1) for the legitimate interests of us and other third parties, including maintaining and administrating the Services; (2) to comply with our legal obligations;

5.2 "Your personal information may also be processed if it is required by a law enforcement or regulatory authority, body or agency or in the defence or exercise of legal claims. We will not delete personal information if it is relevant to an investigation or a dispute. It will continue to be stored until those issues are fully resolved and/or during the term that is required and/or permissible under applicable/relevant law."

5.3 If we intend to further process your data for any other purpose to those set out in this Privacy Policy, we shall provide you with details of this further purpose before we commence processing.

6. Data sharing

6.1 "We may share your personal information with companies, organisations and individuals inside and outside of the IP MIRNYI ANDREI VIKTOROVICH where one of the following circumstances applies:

- c. to other companies in our group, for administrative and management, subject to us taking reasonable measures to ensure that your information is kept secure at all times;
- d. to trusted third parties businesses, or persons who perform services and process your personal information for us for the purposes listed above, based on our instructions, subject to us taking reasonable measures to ensure that your information is kept secure at all times;
- e. to companies, organisations or individuals outside of IP MIRNYI ANDREI VIKTOROVICH if we have a belief in good faith that access, use, preservation or disclosure of the information is reasonably necessary to: o meet any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental

request; o detect, prevent or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues; or o protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of the IP MIRNYI ANDREI VIKTOROVICH, our customers or the public, as required or permitted by law."

6.2 We may share your data other our affiliates. Sometimes we may also need to share your data with a third party in order to provide our services to you or to administer the Site, for example if you choose to share your data across other social media platforms.

7. International Transfers

7.1 We may transfer and maintain on our servers or databases some of your personal information outside the European Economic Area (EEA) including in Russian Federation.

7.2 The countries to which we transfer your data may not have the same data protection laws as your jurisdiction. We take reasonable cyber security measures and/or put in place the Standard Contractual Clauses (e.g. Model Clauses, Data Processing Agreement/Addendum) to ensure your data is adequately protected.

8. Your Rights

8.1 "You have the following rights, in certain circumstances, in relation to your personal information:

- (a) Right to access your personal information.
- (b) Right to rectify your personal information: you can request that we update, block or delete your personal data, if the data is incomplete, outdated, incorrect, unlawfully received or no longer relevant for the purpose of processing.
- (c) Right to restrict the use of your personal information.
- (d) Right to request that your personal information is erased.
- (e) Right to object to processing of your personal information.
- (f) Right to data portability (in certain specific circumstances).
- (g) Right not to be subject to an automated decision.
- (h) Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. "
